3. Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred (100 words or less:

The Solana Beach ECO Rotary Sanitation Project is designed to build five latrines for poor Cambodia rural families in the Kos Khel region, where decent toilet facilities are big issues. ECO Rotary will be coordinating the project through a partner NGO in Cambodia, Solidarity Fund For Rural Development (SFRD), which to date has constructed seventeen latrines. The project will be funded with \$500 from the ECO Rotary and \$500 from a District 5340 matching grant. The latrines are a "double-pit" system with an attached ceramic squatting base surrounded by a simple enclosure.

- 4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects:
  In working with the NGO in Cambodia, Solidarity Fund for Rural Development, we have enhanced the working relationship established a few years ago. Other Rotary clubs in our district have seen the value of the project, and have funded several latrines through us.
  Also, a Rotary club in Utah is exploring the idea of working in cooperation with our club to fund many more latrines in Cambodia.
