- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
The members of the Rotary club purchased food, sorted food contributions and stocked shelves for Got Your Back San Diego. The event took place at the Got Your Back facility in Oceanside on May 13, 2017. Food was purchased the week prior to the event. This organization provided backpacks filled with food on Fridays to school children who are homeless so that the family has food to eat over the weekend.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 7
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
Unpacked and sorted food contributions that were dropped off the day before by a group that had done a food drive for Got Your Back. Stocked shelves with food items including vegetables, fruit, soup, chili, peanut butter, canned meats, snacks, cereal and milk.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 150 homeless families will benefit from this event. Got Your Back San Diego currently provides 150 backpacks filled with food each week to elementary school children.
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The school children are able to have healthy meals on the weekend, so that they can attend school during the week, and are able to learn while in school because they are not malnourished or suffering from hunger pains. They can focus on school, and learn skills to become productive members of society.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Got Your Back San Diego was involved by providing the warehouse where the food is stored, and they are responsible for getting the filled backpacks to the children that are eligible to receive them.
