1	. Briefly describe th	ne project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?		
n e	A free dental clinic was held on November 19, 2016 at Laguna Hills Middle School for school-age children residing in Laguna Niguel and the surrounding local community. The purpose of the dental clinic was to provide dental services to children who do not have dental insurance and cannot afford dental care. Dental services provided included x-rays, cleanings, fillings and extractions. This is a valuable service and was well received by the community. For many low income families, seeing a dentist is a luxury that they cannot afford.			
It should be noted that a total of 83 patients were seen and treated by the attending dentists. The total value of dental services provided was \$41,190. The dental clinic d was well received by the community and was a very successful Club project.

Approximately 14 volunteers assisted directly with the event. Two of the volunteers are practicing dentists who are also members of the Club.
