Purchased new cooking island hood. Removed old one, cleaned area and installed new hood. Ordered 3 new kitchen faucets, which were removed and replaced by a licensed and bonded plumber.

RMH serves families with children in hospital. These families (parents) are able to have a safe environment plus meal whilst supporting hospitalized loved ones. The range hood and faucets are all expected to last for at least 10 years before requiring replacement again.

Individual plumber was required to do the plumbing in order to comply with state and city codes.
