In mid-December, 2016, our Rotary Club will support 200+ families of the Camp Pendleton Marines by assisting with the distribution of Toys for Tots and giving each family a holiday ham and commissary gift card to assist them during the holidays. Additional funds are raised to support the Armed Services YMCA after school and support programs for the year.  
This will be the eighth year in a row that we have done this program.  
Funds will be used to purchase the holiday hams, dry ice, and UHaul truck rental (if necessary) for the families with
