Two clubs collaborated to build fifteen latrines for rural families in Cambodia, managed through Latrines For Life and a partner NGO in Cambodia (SFRD). Members from each club visited the project together in Cambodia this past November (photos and reports funded by this grant are included). The latrines were constructed with the help of the families receiving the latrine. Also added for each family was a soap hand washing station, the Tippy-tap (sample design attached). It's designed as a very inexpensive way to provide "running water" for the washing of hands. Education materials were provided on proper hygiene and the importance of hand washing with a "running water" system.	•
4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded project: Doing the project jointly with the Solana Beach ECO club and the Cache Valley Mornin club (UTAH) turned out to be a real benefit. Members met in Cambodia and visited one the families served. This created a partnership between club members that has inspired the clubs to continue to work together. Already more funds have been secured through their collaboration that will be building more latrines in Cambodia. The future projects will also include a ceramic water filter for each family to give them clean drinking water
