Teachers at Rea Elementary School in Costa Mesa were given the opportunity to submit grant applications for materials and supplies. We received 19 applications and were able to fund 14 of them.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 6 Rotarians reviewed the applications and 3 were involved in purchasing the supplies and delivering them to the school.

The items provided have also increased the books in the library and the material available in the individual classrooms for future years.
