1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? On Dec. 17, 2012, seven members of the club along w/ Interact Club member and family members distributed a Holiday Ham and \$50 commissary gift card to 200 families as they came to the Camp Pendleton Armed Service YMCA to pick up their Toys for Tots presents. The hams and gift cards were given to enlisted families with a rank of E-5 or below.

This was the fourth year that our club has supported the families of the Camp Pendleton Marines stationed overseas by assisting with the distribution of Toys for Tots and giving each family a ham for their Christmas Dinner and a \$50 gift card for the base exchange stores. Additional funds of \$5,500 have been given to the Camp Pendleton Armed Services YMCA to support their after school programs. These programs provide additional emotional and educational support for the children during this period of separation from one of their parents. Contributions from the past 4 years amount to \$15,500.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Camp Pendleton Armed Services YMCA provided with a prominent location to distribute the hams and gift cards to the families.
