

AHRC Shops For A Cause

On August 10, members of the Anaheim Hills Rotary Club reported to the Target Store on Euclid Avenue in Anaheim at 6:45am ready to shop – but not for themselves. Partnering with the Anaheim Family Justice Center, AHRC members, family, and friends escorted AFJC program youngsters as they shopped for school clothing and shoes, with the goal of buying as many items as possible for \$100.

Thirty children, ranging in ages from 5 to 15 participated in the community event, along with volunteer shoppers from Anaheim Hills Rotary Club, AFJC, and the Anaheim Police Dept.

The Anaheim Family Justice Center describes itself as “a safe, confidential, and friendly place where assistance is provided to survivors of domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault and elder/dependent Adult Abuse”.

The \$100 gift cards used for the shopping spree were donated by Anaheim Hills Rotary Club and AFJC. In addition to the school wardrobe items, the

children also received \$50 worth of school supplies, which included backpacks, pencils, pens, notebooks, crayons, and other items.
