Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

. We ordered and distributed approx. 3500 student dictionaries to every 3rd grader in 3 local school districts.

The districts included Denton, Lake Dallas, and Sanger ISDs. Rotarians picked up the dictionaries to take to each school, presented a short program, involved the children in q and a 's about the dictionaries, and generally enjoyed the experience.

One Rotarian offered storage space for the cases of books and staff to put labels in them. Other Rotarians picked up books, took them to schools, presented the program, and gave out dictionaries.

The students often use their dictionaries for years to come. We've had students tell us their older siblings have dictionaries from Rotary, and they are very excited to finally have their own. For some children, these dictionaries are the first book they've ever owned.
