1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Purchase cleaning supplies and food gift cards to be distributed to homeless persons and families transitioning to permanent housing.

Rotarians have purchased items for 17 care packages which were assembled at our weekly club meeting on May 17. The care packages will be given to the Friendship Shelter to be distributed to transitioning homeless persons on an as-needed basis over the next year. In addition, six compact upright vacuum cleaners have been purchased which the Friendship Shelter will make available for use by those who are transitioning into housing that is carpeted.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

So far, 5 Rotarians have purchased the items for the care packages. One Rotarian has worked with the Friendship Shelter to define the need and specify the desired contents of the care packages. Eight more Rotarians assembles the care packages and three will deliver them to the Shelter.

17 homeless persons or families will benefit from this project.

It is hoped that these care packages will make it more likely that the homeless persons and families transitioning to regular housing will be successful in making the transition a permanent one.

The Friendship Shelter provided guidance as to the most-needed items, and will manage the distribution of the care packages to the transitioning homeless persons and families.
