PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- 1. What is the purpose of this project? To support the Fullerton Arboretum's educational programs and demonstrations gardens. The period demonstration garden adjacent to the 1894 Eastlake Victorian Cottage (known as the Heritage House) provide the important backdrop for this unique educational experience. Approximately 4,000 children visit the historic house as part of the Fullerton School District's California history unit. The children are given tours by trained and costumed docents describing what life was like in Fullerton in the late 1890's. The garden is in need of new fencing, plantings and interpretive signage.
- 2. How will it meet the needs of the community? The Heritage House at the Fullerton Arboretum provides a much needed adjunct to the local history component of elementary education. This garden enhancement effort will help provide the appropriate visual context as well as demonstrate the sustainability efforts from over 100 years ago and how they relate to current efforts.
