1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

For this project, the STEM class and Makers Club at Cerro Villa Middle School have built a replica of the Wright Brother's first glider on site at the Cerro Villa School. Additional departments and students have been involved in calculating lift, researching the history of the Wright Brothers, and documenting the school build project. Students, Rotarians, and Educators have all benefitted from this project.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 25 - 100 Rotarians are expected to participate

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Project management - Chad Zimmerman, Lesslie Giacobbi and Ed Carter worked to coordinate material purchases and fabrication. Student oversight - 20 Rotarians visited the project during the build to learn about construction techniques from the students.

Final project - Test Flight: All Rotarians (the entire Rotary Club of Villa Park in addition to any Rotarians from the 5320 District) invited

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? ~300 students and teachers this year

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

A documentary about the construction of the kite is in the works to teach in conjunction with the STEM class curriculum for future years. The kite is built in sections which can be taken apart and rebuilt so that it can be 'rebuilt' in part by future classes and the test-flight can be reproduced year after year.
