Originally, our club was planning to participate in a marine science field trip in the port of Long Beach, CA aboard a boat involving our members, children from CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates), and members from MSA.

Unfortunately, due to COVID 19, MSA postponed all live events (and the CASA children were unable to participate) and in January, 2021 offered virtual events. We are sponsoring three such virtual events for students of Skyview School, and members of our club join the students as they learned more about marine biology.

Skyview School is a K-8th grade alternative education located in Orange and serves primarily at-risk youth.

 Member participation was the interaction with the students during the virtual events.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Approximately 15-20 students participated in the first event. We expect the same attendance for the other two events.
