1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Orange Plaza Rotary partnered with Rise Against Hunger and the Anaheim Hills Rotary Club to package 14,040+ meals containing dehydrated meals of rice, soy, vegetables, flavorings and essential vitamins and minerals. Orange Plaza Rotary contributed to the cost of 8,823 meals and the Anaheim Hills Rotary Club contributed to the rest. The meals were packaged in the multi-purpose room at Solari Enterprises in Orange. The beneficiaries were children and adults suffering from undernourishment around the world.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 8 Rotarians from our club, Rotarians from Anaheim Hills, students from the CPT program at El Modena High School and local volunteers; total of approximately 75 volunteers.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Meals were packaged meals by combining 5 ingredients together in a plastic bag. The meals were then weighed to confirm they were a certain weight. The meals were then sealed and put into boxes for transport.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

The project created 14,040 meals for people in need of nourishing meals.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Undernourished children will be provided with healthy meals and will grow strong. This event brings volunteers in the community together.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Rise Against Hunger organized the event and provided the food supplies, bags, scales, sealers, bins, boxes.


