1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?  
The program will provide oral health and nutrition education to elementary school children at Mills School and Technology Academy and at Orange Grove Elementary School. The target date is Wednesday of next week on May 19.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?  
Normally, 8 to 10 Rotarians help distribute dental health kits to the students, however, this year due to COVID restrictions, teachers will distribute the kits to students in grades K through 5.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.  
The dental kits provide a toothbrush, dental floss, tooth paste and educational material be used in the home.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?  
We will distribute 800 kits to Kindergarten through Fifth graders. In addition, family members of the 800 students will also benefit.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?  
We believe dental health among students is enhanced by this improved education about dental health and by the hands-on tools needed to carry out good dental hygiene.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?  
Rotary uses the services of our partner, Children’s Dental Health Clinic. Due to COVID restrictions, this year’s presentations by the Children’s Dental Health Clinic will be via video and printed material instead of the normal in-person presentations.
