1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries
On May 27, 2022, members of the club will present to students in grades 2nd-4th at RH Dana Elementary School, a presentation on water safety through the Josh the Otter program. The presentation will include interaction with the Josh the Otter mascot (a member in a mascot costume), reading of the Josh the Otter book, giving out books and coloring books, and teaching the students the Josh the Otter song. There will also be a discussion on water safety.
