1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?		
Pathways of Hope is a well-recognized non-profit serving the local homeless and food insecure communities in Fullerton and surrounding communities. The HUB of Hope project recognized exceptional need arising from the pandemic, with many marginal families facing food insecurity, well beyond their agencies typical volume. The District 5320 grant enabled them to provide an additional 800 meals, focusing on families hardest hit by the pandemic. 6 families comprising 30 individuals were the main recipients from this funding source.
