1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Skyview Elementary and Middle School is a fully accredited alternative school that is operated by the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE). From its Orange, California storefront campus, the school provides instruction for approx 60-80 homeless and at risk low-income students. The purpose of the project is to purchase and distribute urgently needed items that were identified that were identified by the school staff.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

Rotarians worked with the school staff to facilitate the selection and purchase of apparel and of a barbeque for use by the school students. Rotarians also purchased. An "award event" and barbecue took place 4/11/2014 in which the items were formally presented to the school by Rotarian members. Rotarian purchased and prepared all of the food on-site at the school. The event was be attended by students, school staff, parents and Rotarians.

Thirty five students and their parents as well as six school staff members

We believe that the items that the grant expenditures have provided for these needy students will improve the learning environment at the school and help them on their way to becoming successful adults.


