1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Over the last several years the price of the Septic Tanks that we have been using in our Rotary/Corazon Sanitation Initiative has nearly doubled as has the cost of transportation from the IE where they are manufactured, and the import duty charged at the Mexican border. These increased costs threatened the future of this life-changing project.

With the fabrication of these molds we will be able to manufacture septic tanks in Mexico taking advantage of reduced labor and material costs, hugely reduced transportation costs and completely eliminating the import duties. These reduced costs will allow this program to flourish and expand bring basic sanitation to many, many more families in Baja Norte.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

There are four Rotarians from YLSR who have been a driving force in the Sanitation Initiative for the 8 years of it's existence. Certainly, every YLSR club member who worked to raise money at Lobsterfest in support of the Sanitation Initiative have all participated. You could also say that the 100's and 100's of Rotarians who have contributed to Corazon Housebuilds with Bathrooms and Sanitation Systems all have participated.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

A) Virtually all of the 35+ sanitation systems that have been installed to date have had heavy Rotary Member participation from fund raising to actual installations right down to the inaugural flush. This will also be true of future systems. Only now they will be more affordable and more common.

B) Rotarians designed, improved and refined this system and the user education program that is also part of it.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

In the most simple terms you could say that that the average sized family the gets one of these systems is 4.5 people and we have completed 35 systems – 157 people have benefitted so far. This number does not consider the neighbors who will benefit that will not have open sewer flowing through their neighborhood. And.... All the additional people who will benefit because these systems are more affordable and easier to come by.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Health – physical, emotional, psychological and spiritual.

These people's lifestyles are moving from the 19th to the 20th century.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Corazon – they fill the role of an NGO. Existing knowledge of recipients needs and the organizational structure to administrate and facilitate.


