- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
Working with Lakewood Project Shepherd, 325 backpacks including paper, pencils, markers, rulers, erasers, notebooks and dividers were acquired and stuffed. These were then handed out to the students at a presentation event.
The process began in mid-August and completed in early September at the Project Shepherd facilities in Lakewood.

Eight Rotarians were involved.

Rotarians were involved with purchasing, stuffing and presenting the backpacks.

325 underprivileged students were directly benefited in addition to providing financial relief to their families.


