On Feb. 20, 2024, we took 24 middle-schoolers, each accompanied by one parent, by chartered bus to Washington, D.C., to celebrate Black History Month. We visited the national monuments on the 20th afternoon, and, after an overnight stay, spent 21st in the Black History Museum. We returned by the same bus on Feb. 21, 2024.

The twenty-four middle-school children benefitted by learning about the civil rights struggle, and black contribution to American culture. They and their parents benefitted through bonding, spending two days together. The humanitarian need was the need for parent-child bonding, and education about black history.
