Dictionaries were donated and delivered to all third grade students in the Chandler Unified School District by members of Sun Lakes Rotary Club.

Dictionaries were prepared on October 12, 2024 and delivered between that date and the end of 2024, all in Chandler, Arizona.

Who were the beneficiaries? Every third grade student in the Chandler Unified School District and the individual schools.

The Rotarians met in the Hamilton High School cafeteria to attach stickers, insert bookmarks and distribute the dictionaries to the various teams for delivery. On various days, coordinated with the individual schools, these and other Rotarians went to the various third grade classes and handed out dictionaries to each student. Additional dictionaries were left with the schools for students who enrolled after the delivery.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Approximately 2900 students and a commensurate number of teachers.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Students will have their own dictionary to use in class and for years to come. This will allow them to access information, learn new concepts and enlarge their vocabulary which will improve their academic performance.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Hamilton High School provided a location for the preparation of the books and the Chandler Unified School District provided access to the third grade classes. The Dictionary Project, a non-profit organization provided the books.
