These students had been given scholarships for their first semester in August 2024, paid for by the Rotary Club's Charitable Fund, before District Grants were formally awarded. These deserving students had remained in school and maintained a satisfactory grade point average throughout their first semester. They were most in need of financial support for their second semester.
