Do you have a good idea? The Rotary Club of Tustin-Santa Ana, in cooperation with TUSD, is sponsoring this annual program offering grants to administrators, teachers and staff members for the development of quality educational programs. Either a new concept or a supplement to an ongoing project is eligible for consideration.

TUSD teachers and staff members can submit their proposals via email to Roger Carlson, rwccpa@aol.com or send the hardcopy through District Mail to Rina Lucchese, Director of Communications and Community Engagement. Proposals need to be submitted no later than 4:00 PM on Wednesday, December 20th.

Each proposal (be creative) must include the following:

- Name of individual, school, and grade level or subject area
- Clever or unique title of proposal
- Brief description of proposal (one page maximum)
- Types of materials or supplies required to implement the program
- Estimated total cost of the project (reasonable budget)
- Estimate number of students this Idea will benefit.
- Principal's signature

A committee of representatives from the Rotary Club and the District will review the proposals and select the winners. A total amount of \$4750.00 has been made available by the Rotary Club to support your "Good Ideas." Individual awards will vary in amount according to the requirements of the proposed projects to a maximum of \$550.00.

Winners will be notified in January. Awards will be presented at the Rotary Club's meeting at 12:10 pm on Thursday, February 1, 2024, at the Santa Ana Elks Club.
