

Connect Our Kids is a nonprofit technology company that keeps foster kids connected to their people – reducing harm and improving outcomes.

The Issue

- Most children in foster care are there for reasons of neglect. With the right supports, many could have stayed with their parents.
- One of the keys to helping struggling parents is to make sure they have supportive friends and family. But families in crisis can be ashamed or afraid to reach out for help.
- Children who do enter care often become disconnected from family and kin. This loss of belonging increases risks of harm, especially for mental health and sex trafficking.
- Foster children placed with safe family members are less likely to run away or be reabused, and they keep their sense of who they belong to, and with--family, not traffickers.

The Opportunity

- Child welfare can keep kids safe and protected by focusing on building supportive relationships, rather than on removing children from families.
- Connect Our Kids' tools and training help make this possible.
- Our Family Connections tool helps a team build a visual map of the family's supports, engage with family and friends to enlist help, and build relationships.
- Our Why Relationships Matter on-demand training teaches teams about the crucial role
 of relationships in the developing child's brain, and how they can help safeguard those
 relationships.
- Our All Connected video series addresses trauma directly with youth and young adults, inviting them to a conversation about their relational health.
- Our training and support team provides our community with the skills and techniques needed to help children and families be in relationship and thrive.
- With our support, users have doubled their rate of kinship placement, improved children's relational health, and kept families together.

Our Approach

- We are a non-profit (501c3) technology company. We believe that relationships matter and we work to keep kids and families connected.
- We do not answer to investors; we answer to you, and the families you serve. Our mission drives everything we do.
- We license our tools to states, Medicaid plan providers, and large child welfare agencies; donors help us provide pro bono licenses to those who are working to connect children with their people, but are not yet able to purchase a license.

 White House Fellow and Presidential Leadership Scholar. She is a nuclear engineer who was
 working in national security when she noticed parallels between software used in the
 intelligence community to map out terrorist networks, and what was needed to connect
 foster kids to supportive family networks.

With a background in communications and philanthropic fundraising, Jessica is passionate about creating meaningful connections for children. She met Jennifer and the idea for Connect Our Kids took off.

Our Team

- We have 12 core team members (5 full-time, 7 part-time), with a development team that fluctuates from 2-20 depending on needs and resources.
- Our volunteers include dozens of foster alumni, social workers, foster and adoptive parents, military veterans, innovative thinkers, college students, marketing professionals, members of the tech community, and lots of regular people who want to help kids.
- Our team has always worked remotely, reducing overhead costs and allowing for maximum team member flexibility. Members of our team are located across the U.S.
