The Water Conservation Garden's Habitat Garden, approximately 4000 square feet, is located next to the Butterfly Pavilion. It will serve as a demonstration garden showcasing drought tolerant native California plants that attract butterflies and local fauna. It will replicate native habitat and serve as an education center for children and adults as to how to create gardens that support the local flora and fauna while conserving water. The Habitat Garden amphitheater will be used for education programs and docent training. The Habitat Garden will open on June 12th, 2015 with a ribbon-cutting ceremony which all Rotarians are invited to attend.
