About The Exhibit

The Native Habitat Garden features plant community-based design and contains natural assemblages of plants, including oak woodland, Coastal Sage Scrub and riparian (streamside) plants arranged as they occur in nature. This new exhibit will provide an opportunity for children and adults to see many beneficial insects and critters otherwise unknown to most city dwellers, to learn about scores of garden-worthy, native plants that are naturally "climate adapted," and to gain a closer relationship to the wilderness of the San Diego region.
