1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Placentia Rotary was the named sponsor for the 1st Annual "Hemophilia Alliance of Orange County Surf Day" event in Huntington Beach on September 20, 2015. The event provided free surfing lessons to children suffering from blood disorders and provided awareness to the Hemophilia Alliance of Orange County. In addition to the surfing, there were several games played, gifts distributed, and snacks provided for anyone stopping by to learn more about hemophilia and its treatment options.
2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 7 of 26 club Rotarians participated in the event and two others helped with the event administration. In addition, there were 5 Rotaract and Interact students that helped.
3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotarians helped set up the tents and tables used for the event, passed out promotional materials for both the Hemophilia Alliance and the Rotary fundraiser that generates funds for this type of grant, and helped with running the event games and distributing snacks.
4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Approximately 200 people were at the beach and stopped by the information tables or accepted promotional materials.
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Long term, the beach community was made more aware of hemophilia and other blood disease victims and the difficulties of being out in the sun for any length of time. The also learned about the Hemophilia Alliance and the things they are doing to help those afflicted with the disease. The event also provided a fun event for about 15-20 children with hemophilia. Many of them had never surfed before.
6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Hemophilia Alliance of Orange County provided the overall organization of the event. The Maui Ola Foundation provided the surfing instructors for the students.
