- 1. 50 children in grades 2 through 8 who do not have dental insurance received dental care including check ups, cleaning, and fissure sealants. Parents and children were counseled on proper dental care. The project was at Orangethorpe School in Fullerton.
- 2. Six Rotarians participated in the project.
