Five or more WSR club members will assist in the unloading and reloading of the school buses and ushering during the concert. WSR members who participated last year reported that the experience was very energizing.

Over 2,000 elementary students primarily from Whittier City Elementary and the Little Lake School District in Santa Fe Springs will attend. Both of these districts have large numbers of low income and English language learning students.
