Please note: the Peso exchange rate has been very volatile the last year swinging from 15 to 17 over a few months and every store exchanges at differing rates.

Uniforms:

The three pages of "Del Mar Uniforms" receipts dated July 20 are for school sweaters, pants, etc. is for 33,277 pesos after discount - with the peso at 16 to the dollar this is equal to: **\$2,079**

The receipts from Mickey Zapaterias is for school shoes purchased in August:

receipt #72789 is for 1555pesos, at 16 to the dollar this is equal to: **\$97**

receipt #72790 is for 1483pesos, at 16 to the dollar this is equal to **\$92**

receipt #72794 is for 1619pesos at 16 to the dollar this is equal to **\$101**

receipt #72795 is for 2781pesos at 16 to the dollar this is equal to **\$173**

Tires:

The two receipts from Torsa for tires are for 4 tires for each of 2 vans:

One dated Sept 30 is for 13730pesos at 17 to the dollar this is equal to **\$817**

One dated Sept 29 is for 13730pesos at 17 to the dollar this is equal to **\$817**

The One Costco receipt (Torsa ran out of our tire size) is for 4 tires for one van: Costco receipt Sept 25 is for 11,276pesos at 17 to the dollar this is equal to **\$675**
