We are able to talk about Rotary's core values and what we do in the community, the nation, and the world. Students are encouraged in the presentation to look up words from the 4-way test, look up information on the state of Texas, as well as a country in the world. If each student plus one person they tell is excited about the book, over 5400 people are impacted by this project during the year.

We again received help from the First United Bank - Rayzor Ranch branch who donated their storage room to receive the ordered dictionaries and their employees then place a label in each book. Each label has the Rotary wheel and the 4-way test. Once this is completed the dictionaries are scheduled for pick up with a Rotarian Dictionary group leader.
