This project is designed with three key objectives:

- Objective #1: Implement the installation of a water well with a pump to enhance water sanitation and hygiene for both people and agricultural purposes,
- Objective #2: Establish a greenhouse for year-round cultivation, and
- Objective #3: Institute a fish farming initiative to enhance the nutritional well-being of both IDPs and the host community.
