Identified Needs:

The care provided at the Comprehensive Center for the Development of the Disabled in Yumbo - CIDDY, has made it possible to see the need to strengthen knowledge in the management of technology and ICTs, since through these tools it is possible to find work; taking into account that we are in the era of co-working, e-commerce, among other services offered through the Internet, work fields that are favorable for people with disabilities, their caregivers, making it possible to work from their own environments. The needs to be addressed will be training, updating and job insertion of people with disabilities and/or caregivers, through a systems room that provides fifty (50) computer equipment, which will be oriented in the training described above, through expert instructors or facilitators with a differential approach who will be articulated through allied entities such as the Municipal Institute of Education for Work of Yumbo - IMETY or SENA.

The adapted vehicle that is needed, will be definitively a must, since some of them lock movility in their extremities and to get to the facilities is very challenging due to the hills and roadways

The beneficiaries will be people with disabilities mainly, however, it is possible that caregivers can also be involved.

The impact is visualized for one hundred (100) people with disabilities. Yumbo have more than 7.500 citizen with disabilities.

SUSTAINABILITY: (Explain how the project will continue to operate once the financial support you receive for this project ends)

The CIDDY Comprehensive Center operates with the support of the municipal administration of Yumbo through the Secretariat of Social Welfare and Participation, which has specialized professionals in the areas of Psychology, Social Work, Physiotherapy and Sports, and also has the articulation of the institutional offer of IMETY and SENA for the training of People with Disabilities and their caregivers. The donated equipment and furniture will be guaranteed to remain on site, receiving maintenance, so that they can serve future generations.
