

FIRST HEARING LOSS DETECTION CAMP AT

ANGAMALY

Project DHWANI – 'the gift of hearing' was inaugurated on 14 August 2022 by Shri Roji M John, MLA of Angamaly, in the presence of Lourdes Hospital Director Rev. Fr Shaiju Thoppil, Rotary District 3201 Governor Rtn Raj Mohan Nair, Rtn Bright Puthenparambil, the President, Rotary Club of Cochin Metropolis, Rtn Paul Varghese, President, Rotary Club of Angamaly and Dr George Kuruvilla, Chair and Director, Project Dhwani.

Despite the lack of fanfare, there were over a 100 registration at the camp. Patients from different part of Kerala, from Thiruvananthapuram to Malappuram attended the camp. Eighteen Patients were advised cochlear implant surgery, eight formiddle ear surgery and twenty-four patients were advised hearing aid trial and fitting. The above selected patients were requested to present themselves for further review at Lourdes Hospital for advanced investigations and pre surgical assessment.

SECOND HEARING LOSS DETECTION CAMP AT EDAVANAKKAD

The second Dhwani camp was held at Edavanakkad on 22 January 2022. This camp was organised in association with Rotary Club of Vypeen Island at the Edavanakkadu service cooperative bank hall. The camp was inaugurated by Edavanakkad Panchayat President Mrs Aseena Abdulsalam.

There were about 42 patients who attended the camp, both from the local area as well as from Alleppey and Kottayam Districts. Ten patients were selected from this camp and were requested present themselves for further follow- up at Lourdes Hospital for investigations.

Eight of the above ten selected patients have been advised middle ear surgery, whereas the two children identified with profound hearing loss will need cochlear implant surgery.

The third Dhwani camp of the year was held on 16th April at Malipuram, Vypeen conducted by Rotary club of Cochin Metropolis in association with Rotary club of Vypeen Island and Suryakala arts club Malipuram. There were about 37 patients seen at the camp who specifically came for hearing loss evaluation. Three patients were selected for surgery to repair ear drum perforation.

SEVENTH DHWANI CAMP PUTHENVELLIKARA, PARAVUR 21ST MAY 2023

The fifth camp of the year was held at Puthenvellikara, Paravur on 21st May 2023. The camp was inaugurated by Fr Vimal, Associate Director Lourdes Hospital along with Mrs Rosy Joshy, President of Puthenvelikkara panchayat and Puthenvelikkara residents' association president Mr Thomas. The camp was well attended with over 75 patients screened. 10 patients were selected for ear surgery.

SELECT BENEFICIARIES

The first surgical patient under Dhwani project was screened at Angamaly Dhwani camp on 14th August 2022.

1) Mr Ajayan is a 48-year-old who had a large perforation in the left ear drum. He also had damage to one of the three bones in the middle ear resulting in significant hearing loss. His perforated ear drum was reconstructed along with reconstruction of the damaged ossicle.



2) The second patient was a 34-year-old lady, **Mrs Remya Krishna** from Edavanakkad camp who underwent a similar surgery for ear drum perforation inMarch 2023.



3) Baby Marian Faith 3yr old girl from Edavanakkad, underwent cochlear implantsurgery under Dhwani project on 3rd February 2023. She was born deaf in bothears and was diagnosed with profound hearing loss at 2 years of age. Her cochlear implants were 'switched-on' on 28th February 2023.

4) 11-year-old **Ms Dainy** from Pallipuram Dhwani camp was the fourth patient under this project to undergo ear drum repair surgery (Tympanoplasty surgery). She underwent left Tympanoplasty surgery on 30/5/2023



5) 59 yr old **Sujatha** from Malipuram camp underwent left Tympanoplasty surgery(left ear drum perforation repair surgery) on 27th June 23.



6) 56 yr **Jessy Benny** from Malipuram camp underwent Tympanoplasty surgeryon 7th July 2023.



7) 27yr old **Neeraj** from Maliupuram camp was diagnosed with bilateral chronic suppurative otitis media (Both his ear drums had a large perforation). He underwent left Tympanoplasty surgery on 30th June 2023.



8) 41 yr old Mrs Rani Manikuttan from Puthenvelikkara camp underwent right Tympanoplasty surgery on 8^{th} August 2023



9) 57 yr old **Mr. Abdul Salam** from Keezhilam campunderwent left Tympanoplasty surgery on 1st August 2023
